## **ACCESS FOR DISABLED PEOPLE IN DUNDEE**

Previous Guides, 1993 – 2003, have been completely revised in 2006. The Premises and Services listed, have been chosen by the Dundee Access Group on the grounds that they have level entry, or only one step, and are wheelchair-friendly. Restaurants etc are only included if suitable toilets are available.

This Guide does not include every suitable venue in Dundee so if you find a good place, which is not included, please tell for our next update.

All Public Buildings should now conform with the Disability Discrimination Act. We always advise that you telephone your chosen venue to see if there are any changes.

## **GETTING ABOUT IN DUNDEE**

All Travel Dundee buses are now wheelchair friendly. There are many Taxis suitable for wheelchairs, but they may not be accessible by people with other disabilities. It is advisable to ask for a "Wheelchair Taxi" or a "Saloon" when ordering by telephone.
